### **Coach Re-Accreditation Guidelines**

Below are the guidelines that are in place for coaches wishing to apply to re-accredit their coaching qualification.

- 1 Coaches whose accreditation expired at the end of 2016 may re-accredit.

Contact your local SANFL coaching contact to obtain the re-accreditation link.

- 2 Coaches whose accreditation expired at the end of 2014 & 2015 may re-accredit providing they have continued coaching. If the coach has had more than 2 seasons not coaching they should complete the online course (click on link below) before they are re-accredited.
- 3 Coaches whose accreditation expired 2011, 2012 & 2013 may re-accredit, providing they have continued coaching. The coach should complete the online course (click on link below) before they can re-accredit. If the coach has had more than 2 seasons not coaching they need to re-sit a course.
- 4 Coaches who have expired prior to 2011 will be required to re-sit a course.

Coaches who need to complete an online course will be required to forward a copy of their online certificate to the SANFL Field Officer to which they are zoned before the re-accreditation process can commence and will be attached to their SportsTG Dashboard.

Once the re-accreditation requirements are complete, a link will be sent to coaches from a SANFL coaching representative when the online re-accreditation process can commence.
