NORWOOD v ADELAIDE

7.20pm Fri April 27 @ Coopers Stadium, Norwood



- : NORWOOD 1-3 (8th) v ADELAIDE 0-4 (10th)
- : Record 4-4, all games played at Coopers Stadium.
- : Last week Crows played 10 on their AFL list including 4 rookies and only 2 with a total of 5 games AFL experience (Fogarty & O'Brien)
- : Crows worst SANFL start was 2015, after 5 games were 0-4-1, first win in 7th game after 0-5-1 start. Finished 8-9-1.
- : Redlegs hosting both AFL clubs in back to back Friday Night games (v Port Magpies May 4th)
- : Last year 2 games split, Adelaide by 2pts in Rd 9, Norwood by 25pts in Rd 14



GLENELG v CENTRAL

2.10pm Sat April 28 @ Gliderol Stadium, Glenelg



- : GLENELG 1-3 (9th) v CENTRAL 2-2 (5th)
- : Last years games won by the home team, Glenelg by 4pts in Rd 4, Central by 97pst in Rd 11.
- : Last 4 games split 2 wins each. At Glenelg Tigers have won 5 of last 6 v Central.
- : All Tme @Gliderol, 26 (GI)-26 (CD) -1
- : Highest score in SANFL history was 49.23 (317) by Glenelg v Central @ Gliderol in 1975.
- : Glenelg's last Grand Final was a 2008 loss to Central.
- : Last year Central replaced Glenelg in the five in the final round of the season.



EAGLES v NORTH

2.10 Sun April 29 @ Maughan Thiem Hyundai Oval, Woodville



- : EAGLES 3-0-1 (1st) v NORTH 3-1 (2nd)
- : Head to Head, Eagles have won last 6, Roosters last win v Eagles, August 2014 @ Prospect.
- : North have not won at Woodville since 2011 (Lost last 7). All time Eagles have won 23 of 27 v North at the ground.
- : North's 3 game winning streak 1st since 2013 Finals Series, last time North won 4 in a row was July 2006.
- : Eagles average slightly more scoring shots 24.8pg to 24 BUT North avg 20+ more points (101.5pg to 81pg) due to superior accuracy (64.6% to 45.5%)
- : Eagles 1st final ('91 QF) & 1st finals win (92 QF) both v North
