Player Safety

SLING TACKLES & DANGEROUS TACKLE

To promote a safe environment in SANFL Juniors ALL sling type and dangerous tackles are to be penalised. If you see any of the following:

- A player lifted off the ground in the tackle
- Two distinct actions in the tackle
- Or Intent to hurt by force in the tackle

You must be vigilant in this area. **IF IN DOUBT** – err on the side of paying a free kick !

MODIFIED Tackle applies in:

- Under 9 & 10
- Under 12 Girls

Red/Yellow Card incidents

- Offending player details, nature of incident as required on the app
- RED Card – ALSO complete form at this link and email

- **(CHANGE OF TIME)** Umpires Incident Report Form **MUST be submitted by 9AM** to allow Competition Management to start the process

Reminders from Round One

- RED/YELLOW Cards
 - There is NO scope to upgrade, downgrade or withdraw a card issued on match day. You must stick with what you have done.
 - Any variation may occur following incident assessment and at the discretion of Competition Management
 - In all cases, please ensure the relevant club players and officials are advised of details of all cards issued

- Correct SANFL Juniors uniform is:
 - Orange/green shirt with National Pharmacies Optical/Channel 7 logos
 - Grey Shorts
 - Grey Socks
 - If you do not have any of the above correct uniform items please email Leanne.Carter@sanfl.com.au to order
- Three (3) umpires failed to turn up or arrived late to their matches last weekend
 - Unacceptable. There is a communication process in place to your coach if this situation arises
- We are currently MISSING votes/club ratings from 20+ matches. As per Umpires Match Day Guide if the Matchday Paperwork App does not work please email required information to votes@sanfl.com.au by 9am Monday
 - We will be following up missing information shortly from matches/umpires
- Barging – the Dustin Martin “fend off” is to be penalised in those grades that do not allow barging or bumping
 - Under 7 to Under 10 Boys
 - In other grades if the “fend off” is high, to the face, etc it is to be penalised
