July School Holidays

- SANFL Juniors
 - NO matches will be played 13/15 July & 20/22 July
- SANFL Schools
 - On July 7 matches will be played at Ridley Reserve **only**
 - NO matches will be played on 14 July & 21 July
- Umpire Training
 - NO training during the two weeks of school holidays (Monday July 9th – Friday July 20th incl) at any training venue. Training will resume from the week commencing Monday July 23rd
- Additionally, NO training at Para Hills FC on July 2

Reminders

- Footwear – grounds are becoming soft & muddy. Please ensure you are wearing appropriate footwear. Football boots are acceptable – slipping over or avoiding running through the mud is not acceptable
- Stretcher – play **MUST** be stopped when any umpire is advised or is aware a stretcher is on the field
- Observation of the Last Act of Play – keep an eye on the disposer of the football (by hand or foot) for a split second. This will enable you to see & penalise any late contact that occurs on the disposer
- Behind Play – As No. 2 umpire when not in control of play take a moment to look behind you from time to time and observe players in your area. A reminder by voice to any players niggling each other may prevent it becoming a bigger issue.
- Last Possession Out of Bounds – this rule eliminates the need to pay any deliberate out of bounds free kicks
- Deliberate Rushed Behinds – we do not pay this in SANFL Juniors/SANFL Schools

SANFL Schools

- ONLY SANFL Schools matches which require team behaviour ratings which will appear on the MDP app

From Match Day Guide (SANFL Schools)

- Good Sports Votes relating to team behaviours are required in matches in the Woodville West Torrens/Eagles School Football Zone
- Bruce Potter Award relating to team behaviours is required in matches in the Norwood/North Adelaide School Football Zone
- If you umpire a SANFL Schools match in any other school football zone NO team behaviour ratings are required

Also, Umpire Appreciation is not necessary in SANFL Schools matches at this stage

National Boys & Girls Under 15 Australian Football Championships will be held in Adelaide this year from Sunday 22nd July – Saturday 28th July (No games Tues 24th & Friday 27th)

Each state/territory will bring a Field, Boundary & Goal Umpire, however, we need to provide the following number of umpires to fill each of the 8 daily games

- Field – 6 (\$50 per game)
- Boundary – 10 (\$30 per game)
- Goal – 4 (\$25 per game)

Boys games are 4 x 16 min quarters

Girls games are 4 x 15 min quarters

Umpires will be allocated to 1 of the 8 games played per day (4 boys & 4 girls), with starting times of 9:00am, 10:45am, 12:30pm & 2:15pm. (2 different venues)

In the case where we have insufficient Boundary or Goal Umpires, it may be possible to do more than 1 game per day to cover the shortfall.

It is preferable that umpires are available for all 5 days of the Championships, as this will help us determine who officiates the 2 Grand Finals & 6 Placings games on the Saturday.

School Sport SA are able to provide a verification note to validate school absences on the Mon, Wed & Fri during this week (Wk 1 Term 3)
